Program Overview

The MIT Innovation Leadership Bootcamp was organized by the Abdulla Al Ghurair Foundation for Education, in collaboration with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), and United Arab Emirates University (UAEU).

The 10-week bootcamp that kicked off in Dubai on February 15th brought together high achieving Emirati and Arab youth.

The participants were divided into teams and were tasked to work on innovative projects that tackle unemployment challenges faced by Arab youth.

Objective

The bootcamp aims to sharpen creative collaboration, customer discovery and project design skills, that help youth extract, conceptualize, and convert ideas into reality in the entrepreneurial space.
