Siraj is a 6-week-long program which aims to provide 300 Emirati youth with critical skills to enhance their competitiveness and prepare them for the job market. Siraj focuses on developing youth's storytelling skills, identified by the World Economic Forum as future skills. By leveraging sessions delivered by senior industry executives and leading journalists from CNN, Siraj empowers participants with the tools needed to better tell their own stories. The program also provides learners with experiential learning opportunities and hands on projects.
