
Nomu Regional Expansion

Following its success in the UAE, the Foundation has expanded Nomu to the Arab region, starting in Jordan, Lebanon, and Tunisia in 2023, with plans to pursue other Arab countries in subsequent years.

The expansion followed the **Nomu UAE** model, applying the 3Cs approach to ensure programs are contextualized, comprehensive, and centered around the needs of youth. The Foundation partnered with three experienced and locally based organizations: Al Hussein Technical University (HTU) in Jordan, Digital Opportunity Trust (DOT) in Lebanon, and Fondation Tunisie pour le Développement (FDT) in Tunisia.

Nomu's regional expansion provides three pathways catering to diverse needs:

- 1. Bridge programs: foundational courses and English language support.
- 2. Upskilling opportunities: short, accredited, and certified digital upskilling programs that are aligned with market needs.
- 3. Business skills support: for talented youth and young entrepreneurs.
