The Foundation uses a three-step model to develop its programs:



Identification

Design

Implementation

Closely monitoring solutions that are implemented by partner organizations to ensure maximum impact.

Following this approach, the Foundation's work aligns with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 5 (Gender Equality), SDG 8 (Decent Employment), and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals). The Foundation embraces the Nexus model, recognizing the interconnection of the SDGs, and the alignment with the national UAE Vision 2030.
